Language requirements	<p>Our lectures are delivered in German. Therefore we strongly suggest all incoming students to prepare their knowledge of the German language thoroughly before coming to Darmstadt. The exams are generally in German and there is no guarantee that the professor will offer the option of taking it in English. That is why we ask the students to send us a confirmation of their German language skills along with her/his application (certificate of attendance for the German language course for example).</p>
Intensive German language course before the semester	<p>One month before the start of our semester, we offer an Intensive German Language Course. This course takes place during March for the summer semester and during September for the winter semester. It is free of charge and participants may obtain 6 ECTS. German language course during the semester	<p>In addition to this Intensive Course, there will be German courses during the semester. Those will be adapted to the level of German of the student. In order to do so, a compulsory grading test will be done at the beginning of the semester. The result of that test will decide about the course the student will be assigned to.
