



EGE UNIVERSITY GENERAL INFORMATION

- Ege University was established in 1955 and is one of Turkey's leading campus universities.
- Ege University is a state university that acts as a focal point for education, research, cultural and social activities in the city of Izmir and the Aegean region.
- Ege University Encourages and puts high emphasis on both basic and applied research. Ege University is the **University of Choice** for motivated students.
- Ege University is a university with an international perspective.
- Ege University is a **Campus University** located in Bornova, a district of Izmir. Easily accesible from all parts of the city.
- Recreational & Social Centers that accommodate various cultural and arts activities.
- There are 11 Faculties, 3 Graduate Schools, 7 four-year Schools, 5 Institutes, 7 two-year Vocational Training Schools, 26 Research Centers, 47.000 Undergraduate+Graduate students, 3.192 Teaching staff, 4000 Administrative staff at Ege University.



STUDENT LIFE

- EGE University has a wide reputation for the quality of its social and cultural activities, which take place on the Campus.
- Ege University offers opportunities for personal, cultural, social and professional development that complement the richly complex and challenging academic life.
- One of the most favored social and cultural activities in Ege University is the traditional Sports and Arts Festival organized every year during May.
- Central Library has a centralized collection of books and journals nearly all of which are on open shelves and easily accessible to users. It has been designed to provide the latest electronic and multimedia resources.
- EGE University provides its students with facilities for a variety of sports.
- EGE University has 60 student clubs, which are active in many diverse fields of interest.
- EGE University's health services are a fully comprehensive service providing a full range of medical and dental services to the students.
- Advisory and Counseling Services Center offers comprehensive and confidential advisory and counseling services to the students.
- Turkish Language courses are organized by Turkish Teaching Center for foreign students.
- A Shopping Center located in the center of the Campus.
- Estimated living expenses for international students are minimally 300 to 400 Euros per month.





ACCOMMODATION

- Accommodation for national and international students is available in Student Village for 1600 students located in the Campus area.
- Student Village is located in the Campus area.
- All rooms furnish bedding and internet connection is available.
- All buildings have common areas such as self-cook kitchens, TV/social lounges, study lounges, self-service laundry and ironing rooms, and game and visitors' areas.
- A big shopping center near where students can do shopping and find all sorts of products and services they need.



ORIENTATION

- International Office & ESN organizes an orientation program to help the students adapt to living in a new environment and culture.
- Orientation Program gives exchange students an opportunity to get to know the University life, the department, administration, social and cultural services, Izmir city and all other new students.
- Orientation Program covers city tour and trips to nearby historical sites.

VISA & RESIDENCE PERMIT

- A student visa is required to register as a student in Turkey.
- Student visa must be obtained from a Turkish Consulate; it cannot be obtained within Turkey.
- Residence Permit is obtained from the Bureau of Foreign Residence Registration at the provincial Directorate of Security within a month.



INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS

- International and European cooperation plays an important role in the development of Ege University. Ege University International Office coordinates and supports international cooperation activities and provides assistance and guidance to international faculty and students in Ege University.
- Ege University upholds its commitment to coordinate and implement European Union's new "Life Long Learning (LLP) " and " Youth " Programs. Ege University has been awarded by Erasmus University Charter and takes part in Life Long Learning –LLP and Youth Programs between 2007-2013
- Ege University has ranked the first in number of student and teaching staff mobility in 2004-2005 and 2005-2006 academic years among Turkish universities. Ege University has also ranked the first in number of student mobility in 2008-2009 academic year.
- Ege University has developed 380 bilateral agreements with European universities in the scope of LLP/Erasmus Program for 2011-2012 academic year. And the planned number of outgoing students is about 500.
- Dual Diploma Programs: State University of New York (SUNY) – U.S.A, Fachhochschule für Wirtschaft Berlin – Germany, Cartagena Polytechnic University – Spain, Fachhochschule Giessen Friedberg – Germany.
- Ege University has entered into 73 academic cooperation protocols with many foreign institutions all over the world to promote the enrichment of teaching and research programs.
- Diploma Supplement Label has been awarded to Ege University by the European Commission in April 2005 and May 2009.
- Studying and working abroad (placement) are considered a valuable opportunity to strengthen the European perspective in student's professional development.
