

INFORMATION SHEET FOR LLP - ERASMUS INCOMING STUDENTS

Application process

Erasmus students must send all the application documents <u>directly</u> to our International Relations Office:

For the application you need the following documents:

- application form (see instructions below)
- copy of your transcript of records
- learning agreement
- a photocopy of your Identity Card (valid for your whole Erasmus mobility period)
- a photocopy of your Insurance card (valid for your whole Erasmus mobility period)

- A certificate printed and signed by your International Office attesting that you are an Erasmus student

Fill the application form in, print it out and send it duly signed and stamped by your University International Office to the following address:

Provisionally accepted students will be published on the above mentioned web page from July 30_{th} . Application deadline for the first semester and the whole academic year is July 15_{th} , 2011 and for the second semester is November 15_{th} , 2011

Accommodation process

Accommodation Form must be done in every case, even if you will apply for a private accommodation.

It is highly recommended to apply for accommodation at one of the Universities student houses. Housing for international students is organized by the SASSA Service.

When you apply for studying at our University you should also apply at the same time for accommodation:

Application deadline for the first semester and the whole academic year is July 15_{th} , 2011 and for the second semester it is November 15_{th} , 2011.
