Language requirement	We insist that our exchange students should have a minimal knowledge of French (or English if all their courses are in English) to attend classes and take exams. <u>Therefore we ask them to join to their Application Form a document testifying their level of French (or English).</u> The minimal required level is B1 (B2 for HEC-Management School) (Common European Framework of Reference).
