Application Procedure for International Students Before the arrival	Students have to fill in the Online Application Form and the University has to send by post to LUMSA University: a) Declaration by the university to which the student belongs that the student in question is an exchange student; b) Certificate by the student's university that the student in question is enrolled at that university and Transcript of Records; c) Original Application form (a completed and signed application for registration); d) Learning agreement signed by the home coordinator; e) International health insurance; f) Passport (photocopy); g) Two photographs suitable for such documents.
Application Deadlines	- until June 30th (I Semester or Full Academic Year) - until November 30th (II Semester)
