All students who are living on-campus should check with the appropriate residence office for further details.</p>	<p><b>Exam Periods:</b> Fall: Dec 8 – 19, 2014 Winter/Spring: Apr 13 – 27, 2015</p> <p>All students must remain available for the exam period; there are no special arrangements to write exams back home for incoming exchange students.</p>

<p><b>Mandatory Fees</b></p>	<p>All students including exchange students are required to pay Organization fees per the University of Manitoba mandate. These fees will be approximately \$75 per term and will vary based on the number of registered courses.</p> <p><b>Fee Deadline:</b> September 10, 2014 (Fall Term) January 13, 2015 (Winter Term)</p> <p>Fees must be paid by the deadline or late fees will be incurred. <p><b>Other Housing Options</b></p>	<p><b>Home Stay- Living with a Canadian Family</b> The Homestay Program is organized through the English Language Centre at the University of Manitoba. Learning Expectations	
<b>Language of Instruction</b>	English
<b>Class format</b>	Lectures, class analysis/presentations, papers & projects
<b>Class Participation</b>	Class Participation is required for most classes
<b>Course Grading</b>	Letter graded, with a D being a marginal pass
<b>Class Size</b>	Normally 40-60 students
<b>Course load:</b>	3-4 courses are suggested
<b>Course choices:</b>	Exchange students can select any course that is offered during their exchange semester as long as the student meets prerequisite requirements and there is space available in the course. Some courses may require professor approval for enrolment.
<b>Examinations</b>	Format of exams vary. Final exams are written in the last 2 weeks of the school. Students are responsible to stay in MB until they complete all exam requirements. Requests of early leave of exams are usually not considered.
