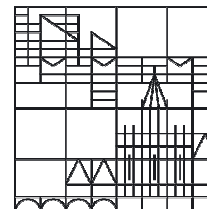






<p><i>Academic calendar</i></p>	<p><b>The academic year for exchange students starts in October and ends in July. It is divided into 2 independent terms (semesters). <p><i>Supporting documents required to be submitted with exchange application</i></p>	<p><b>Application Form (will be sent to student in a welcome email) plus</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- short CV</li> <li>- letter of motivation</li> <li>- current transcript from your home university</li> <li>- Proof of German or English language skills</li> <li>- Application for Student Housing (if interested)</li> <li>- Application for the Intensive Language Course with Integrated Orientation (strongly recommended)</li> </ul> <p>Application for the Orientation Program (only if not applying for the Intensive Language Course with Integrated Orientation)</p>

<b>Transcripts</b>	Upon completion of the semester/year, the student fills out an Application for Transcript when all grades have been posted. The International Office then issues an official transcript and sends it to the home university.
<b>Level and numbers</b>	Undergraduate and Graduate (Postgraduate) <b>Overseas:</b> usually 2 full-year exchange students, but places are negotiable. <b>ERASMUS:</b> according to the valid Bilateral Agreement.
<b>Number of credits</b>	Undergraduate and graduate students are usually enrolled in 30 credits per semester; deviations are possible

<b>Language requirement (e.g. TOEFL/IELTS/others)</b>	Exchange students should be fluent in either English or German. This translates to a B1/2 level of the Common European Frame of Reference for Languages.

<p><b>Accommodation</b></p>	<p><b>Students who apply for and pay the deposit in time are usually guaranteed accommodation in Seezeit Student Housing.</b></p> <p>The application form and details on the housing deposit are included in the <a href="#">Information Package</a> provided on the International Office homepage. Please note: it is crucial that the housing deposit arrive in Konstanz by the deadline.</p> <p>Unfortunately, there is no assistance; finding private housing in Konstanz also is very difficult and expensive. Good websites to look for accommodation on are <a href="http://www.vierwaen.de">www.vierwaen.de</a> , <a href="http://www.wg-gesucht.de">www.wg-gesucht.de</a> , <a href="http://www.studenten-wg.de">www.studenten-wg.de</a> . You can find offers from private landlords in the local daily newspaper Suedkurier: <a href="http://www.suedkurier.de">www.suedkurier.de</a></p> <p>Private housing is best found when on-site; bring time and patience.  <b>Please be aware of scans – ad written in English, passport copies of landlord sent, money to be sent via Western Union.</b></p>
<p><b>Estimated expenses per month (in local currency)</b></p>	<p><b>Accommodation:</b> 350-420 Euros per month  <b>Food:</b> 120-250 Euros/month  <b>Local transportation:</b> semester student pass 45 Euros  <b>Printing</b> (50-100/sem), <b>insurance</b> (75/mon), <b>campus fees</b> (60/sem)  <b>Personal:</b> 150-450 Euros/month (depends on individual habits, of course: travelling, partying, choosing expensive foods in the cafeteria ...)</p>
<p><b>Visa requirements</b></p>	<p><b>Visa:</b>  Citizens from EU/EEA countries and Switzerland, the US, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Japan, South Korea, Israel and Brazil do not need a visa to enter Germany. All others NEED a student visa (NOT a tourist visa) that students have to apply for ahead of time.</p> <p><b>Residence Permit:</b>  ALL students (except from EU/EEA countries and Switzerland) will apply for a residence permit (“Aufenthaltstitel”) in Konstanz upon arrival. The IO will assist.</p>
<p><b>Medical insurance</b></p>	<p>Students from the EU/EEA and Switzerland are automatically insured through their EHIC card.  Non-EU/EEA students <b>are required</b> to enroll in German health insurance; the IO will assist with this upon arrival.</p>

<p><b>Services available to exchange students (e.g. internet access, sports facilities, libraries, student organizations, local transport etc)</b></p>	<p>All exchange students enjoy the same access to university facilities as local students. To mention just a few facilities such as computer centre, Internet access both on the university campus as well as in the accommodation, access to sport facilities: (<a href="http://www.uni-konstanz.de/hochschulsport">www.uni-konstanz.de/hochschulsport</a>) and the library (<a href="http://www.ub.uni-konstanz.de/">www.ub.uni-konstanz.de/</a>)</p> <p>In the <a href="#">Studierenden-Service-Zentrum (SSZ)</a> students have access to all services in one room.</p> <p>The <a href="#">Welcome Center</a> offers special services to PhD.</p> <p>In addition to that, a Counseling Center offers advice and services in times of stress and worries.</p> <p>Other services include</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- TANDEM-Language Partner</li> <li>- University Sports Programs</li> <li>- Career Service</li> <li>- Access to an array of excursions</li> </ul> <p>Access to Student Initiatives and Activities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.
